A nursery service will be established, although parents' collaboration will be needed.

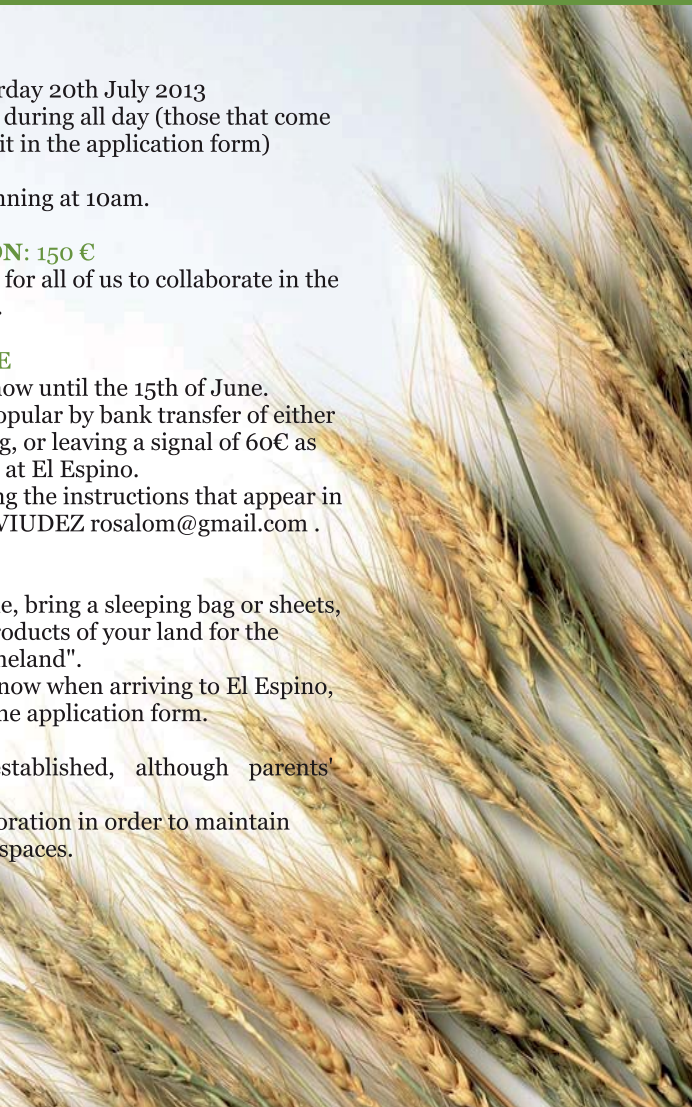
We count on everybody's collaboration in order to maintain friendly and cozy all monastery spaces.
